State Representative Stephanie Cummings reported:

- Gov. Lamont set a \$100.00 fine to anyone found without a mask when in public

- Gov. Lomont received a 90-day extension of his power.
- Bill for police accountability was passed
- Farms to Family will be held on September 26th from 4 to 7 pm at Crosby High School. This is a drive by event.
- Please wear your masks.
